



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Our Story

Learn 2 Cornwall Ltd was established in 2021, however, was many years in the making!

After being a teacher for over 16 years, working as a Service Manager with Mencap and then creating, building and managing another specialist post-16 provision locally, Kyrstie's passion was ignited within both education and adult social care settings and day placements.

We have seen many young people thrust into adulthood with very little skills gained throughout education where they then slip through the cracks when they finish. This is what we want to change.

Our vision is to offer as many skills, qualifications and opportunities as possible working on an individual basis where we can and take a holistic approach to becoming an adult.

Our programmes are available to all young people aged 16+ with an EHCP. We could be a stepping stone into colleges for those who are not quite ready as well as providing successful transitions out of education into adulthood and much more in-between.


Becky Smith - Careers Specialist & Work Experience Co-Ordinator



What we offer

New in 24/25



Steps 2 is our foundation level programme. This is a hybrid of class/group learning as well as 1:1 provision.

The purpose of this programme is to offer continued education for those who may be working at a low level e.g pre entry/entry 1/entry 2. We tailor as much of the programme around each young person as possible.


There are no formal entry requirements for this programme. All places are allocated based on if needs can be accommodated.

Our Core Programme

Live & Work does exactly what it says! Provides skills for both independent living whilst offering as many work experience opportunities as possible.

This is also our longest running programme offering qualifications from entry level 3 to level 2.

The objective of this programme is to encourage learners to find their direction whether this be work, volunteering or life long learning.

This programme was developed in 2022/23 following requests from parents.

We spend the entire year building confidence in independent living skills as well as work/volunteering.

The main goal of this programme is to create a secure future after education which answers the question – ‘what does life look like after education?’

Me 2 enables us to engage in meaningful conversations with all parties involved and collaboratively design a personalised programme tailored to the individual's needs. We remain flexible and committed to helping where we are able to.




What We Cover

Independent Living Skills

From cooking, washing, understanding labels, ironing and shopping to personal health and hygiene, managing money and staying safe. All learners need to have skills that will support them to become more independent. This enables them to address the 'preparing for adulthood' section of their EHCP.

We teach these skills in conjunction with either a particular vocational qualification and/or work experience.



Qualifications



New for 2024/25 we will be offering an English & Maths hub for all learners. For some, this may be a formal qualification and for others this may be embedded into everyday learning and living. Our new hub offers a very unique way of teaching Maths & English specifically for young people with learning disabilities. English & Maths can actually be lots of fun and we are happy to show you what this looks like this academic year!

In addition to the above, we currently offer qualifications in Skills for Living & Work as well as Employment Development Skills. These allow us to mix and match many modules in order to build a curriculum that works both for groups as well as individuals.



Work Experience/Volunteering



We aim to offer a wide range of opportunities across various industries. We currently offer a minimum of five different work or volunteer placements throughout the year - more than any other provider in the area.

We believe it's important for young people to contribute to and support the local community and economy, whether through paid employment or volunteering. To achieve this, we collaborate with community projects and local businesses to maximise the opportunities available.


Recognising that many young people are still exploring their future career paths, we aim to provide as many varied experiences as possible. This helps promote choice and supports informed decision-making about their next steps.

How to enrol with us

Contact your Careers Advisor

FIND OUT WHO YOUR LOCAL ADVISOR IS AND MAKE CONTACT WITH THEM ASAP - YOU WILL NEED THEIR HELP.

Careers Advisors are required to be involved with all changes to education, which include changing from 1 provider to another. You must speak with them asap in order to find out what is available.

Go and visit all potential provisions

MAKE APPOINTMENTS AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE

In order to make the right choice for your next steps you must visit all potential provisions to get all the information before making your choice.

Choose your next provision

GO BACK TO YOUR CAREERS ADVISOR AND CONFIRM YOUR CHOICE

The Careers Advisor will then write a report which is sent to County in order for the process to start. This can take a long time so the earlier you start the earlier you will know what is happening.

ENSURE LEARN2 CORNWALL IS ADDED TO YOUR EHCP REVIEW

We can always attend your annual review if you wish but this must be booked in asap.
